### **ENTERING AVALANCHE TERRAIN**

The terrain and travel routes beyond this point are in backcountry avalanche tenain. This area contains potentially dangerous slopes and avalanche paths that are not patheted or controlled. Proceed at your own risk and only with the proper training and equipment.
